Program requirements:

Avery Permanent Housing serves transitional living for the youth ages 18-25.

About the program:

The Avery Permanent Housing Placement Housing is a twelve-unit apartment complex that provides permanent supportive housing to transition age youth ages 18-25. This includes youth who are chronically homeless, at-risk of becoming homeless, aging out of foster care, or victims of domestic violence. A unique component of Believe and Faith is the inclusion of six mentors who live on the premises and serve as role models for the residents and help facilitate activities.

Residents may access a full range of supportive services on-site including:

- Case management
- Employment counseling
- Independent living skills
- Counseling
